

## Convention Update June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017

### MSP Club Touring

The Convention is fast approaching and we have been working to finalize all the details. At the last Governors Meeting we talked about doing “touring” laps at the Motorsports Park Track one day. We have all the details in place to do this on Wednesday, August 23rd. We will have a morning and afternoon session and the cost will be \$40.00 per driver. “Touring Laps” will consist of at least one session of the entire motorsports track and depending on how well the participants behave we hope to have multiple runs available in the morning and afternoon groups. The “touring laps” consist of groups of 4 or 5 cars, led by a track employee around the course at a moderate speed for at least (2) laps per run.

Sign up via email to the convention treasurer is required for scheduling purposes. When sending the email to Cindy Urenda ([Convention2017@corvettesnccc.org](mailto:Convention2017@corvettesnccc.org)), please include your NCCC number, convention number and whether you are signed up for the low speed event. Those attending convention on a day pass are not eligible to participate in the club touring. Registration for this event closes August 1 like the rest of the events.

Once the morning and afternoon sessions for the low speed have been established, we will assign the club touring sessions. The (2) sessions will be run at the same time as the low speed event on Wednesday August 23, 2017. Because of this it will not be possible to run the touring laps in the same time frame as your Low Speed Event scheduled time.

Be prepared to be at MSP for the **mandatory** information meeting prior to starting your touring session- around 8:15 for the morning session and around 12:15 for the afternoon session. At this point this opportunity is available to Corvettes only and the driver assumes all responsibility for the time on the track. This is not a competitive event and there will not be any timing. Further the MSP reserves the right to ask anyone to leave the track for not obeying the track rules as put forth in the drivers meeting.

If you want to be with specific other drivers, you will need to line up that way.
