2. Any vehicle that, in the opinion of the tech inspector, would constitute a danger to life and limb, will not be allowed to enter and the driver shall be refunded the entry fee.
3. Upon passing inspection, a vehicle shall be marked with a visible check or sign, the vehicle number and the class. Numbering of entrants' cars shall be done in a manner as to not bring unnecessary attention to the entrant during the course of the event. Any means of numbering affixed for a Rallye or an Economy Run **MUST** be removed or covered at the completion of this event. Cards placed on the dashboard are recommended.
