- Krushchev is deposed
- Congress approves Gulf of Tonkin Resolution
- Martin Luther King Jr wins Nobel Peace Prize
- Stamps are \$0.05
- Beatles appear in Ed Sullivan
- Songs: "Dang Me" by Roger Miller
- Movies: "Dr Strangelove" and "Zorba the Greek"
- TV: "Payton Place" premieres
- Ford introduces the Mustang
- Toys: Play Doh, GI Joe and Password
- First year of the Kennedy Half Dollar

In 1964...

- The Corvette Convertible cost \$4037 and 13,925 were produced while the Coupe cost \$4252 and 8,304 were produced
- The previous year's distinctive rear window divider was replaced by a solid piece of glass.
- The fake hood vents were eliminated and the roof vents were restyled.
- A three-speed fan was available in the coupe to aid in ventilation.
- All were available with a Black, White, or Beige soft top.
- Only 3.2 percent of 1964 Corvettes were sold with the standard three-speed manual transmission.
- An L84-powered 1964 Corvette could go from 0-to-60 mph in 6.3 seconds and from 0-to-100 mph in 14.7 seconds.
- It had a top speed of 138 mph.
- Genuine leather seat trim \$80
- Sebring Silver exterior paint \$80.70
- Soft-Ray tinted glass, all windows \$16.15
- 36-gallon fuel tank for coupe only \$202.30
