

## The Year Was 1991...

## In 1991...

- The Corvette ZR-1 cost \$64,138 and 2,044 were produced, the Convertible cost \$38,770 and 5,672 were built while the Coupe cost \$32,455 and 14,967 were built
- A new front end with wrap-around parking lamps was used on both models, along with new side-panel louvers and wider body-color body side moldings.
- Although more alike the standard Corvette in a visual sense, the ZR-1 again had different doors and a wider rear to accommodate its 11-inch wide rear wheels.
- Also the high-mounted stop lamp went on the roof of the ZR-1, instead of on the rear fascia, as on the YY Corvette.
- All models were again equipped with ABS II-S anti-lock braking and driver's side airbag as well as an anti-theft system.
- The \$33,000 Callaway Twin-Turbo engine package could again be ordered through specific Chevrolet dealers as RPO B2K
- Callaway built its 500th conversion on September 26, 1991.
