In 1993...

- The ZR1 cost \$66,278 and 3448 were built, the Convertible cost \$41,195 and 5,712 were produced while the Coupe cost \$34,595 and 15,898 were produced
- Corvette for 1993 marked its 40th Anniversary with a special appearance package, \$1,455, that included an exclusive "Ruby Red" exterior and interior with color-keyed wheel centers, headrest embroidery and bright emblems on the hood, deck and side-gills.
- Improved air flow from cylinder head and valve train refinements boosted its rating from 375 hp to 405 hp!
- The 1993 Corvette also introduced GM's first Passive Keyless Entry system whereby simply leaving or approaching the Corvette automatically unlocked or locked the appropriate doors.
- The 1993 Corvette was also the first North American automobile to use recycled sheet-molded-compound body panels.

- Delco-Bose Stereo System with Compact Disc changer was \$1219
