


NCCC has to offer; this is maintained by the *NCCC Director of Public Relations*.

The **National Council of Corvette Clubs (NCCC)** was established in 1959 by a small group of Corvette Owners and Enthusiasts as an all-volunteer, non-profit organization. Since 1959 most things have changed however, since inception, NCCC's purpose was and still is to promote interest in Corvette ownership and operation. To publish information on the use and operation of the Corvette and to establish an organized effort to encourage others to participate in the enjoyment connected with the use and ownership of *America's Sports Car – the Corvette!*



As an individual or Corvette Club, you might ask “what’s in it for us, why should we become a member of NCCC?” We have assembled this brief flyer to show you a few of the major benefits of what NCCC has to offer.

- ◆ **We are an organization interested in our Youth and their education.** What other organization makes it so easy or inexpensive to pass your Corvette enthusiasm to the younger generations? We enable this thru the *NCCC Future Corvette Owners Association (FCOA)* which has a minimal, one-time fee for youths up to age 16. 
- ◆ To further assist in the education of our members and dependents, **NCCC offers a Scholarship Program** which promotes and assists with education. The NCCC Scholarship program is funded through donations from Clubs, individuals and corporate partners such as *Mid America Motorworks*. In addition, you will find that many of our regions also offer additional scholarship programs to directly assist their members and dependents in their region. 
- ◆ **NCCC is an organization with a focus on Charities and Grants**, which began in 1975 and has grown steadily; not

only in dollar amounts given but also in the area of service. Through the years since 1975, NCCC has donated over \$1.5 million to the *Muscular Dystrophy Association, the Spina Bifida Association of America and the National Kidney Foundation.*



For the past several years, NCCC has hosted a charity raffle to win a new Corvette with proceeds benefiting charity. Under the **Grants Division**, we have provisions for member hardships.

- ◆ If you have ever hosted any variation of club event, you know that **event insurance** is very costly. As an NCCC affiliated club, you automatically receive insurance covering all club events; for a one-time annual fee. This coverage not only covers your clubs events including car shows to competition events but also protects you when enjoying day and weekend cruises / caravans. Our insurance coverage extends far beyond hosting events; it also protects your club against malicious prosecution, libel, slander, right of privacy violation, wrongful entry or eviction.



- ◆ NCCC also offers you the **support of members around the country** who have a vast wealth of information and knowledge. We have found that it doesn't matter if it is a part you're looking for, knowledge to learn how to perform a modification, car issues during a trip, down to having a family or health issue; with NCCC the *Family Helping Family* program is available and a benefit supporting you!

- ◆ NCCC offers various **annual National Contests** which include the *Duntov Award, the Eagle-One Golden Rule Award*, in addition to a *National Club Newsletter and Website Contest*.
